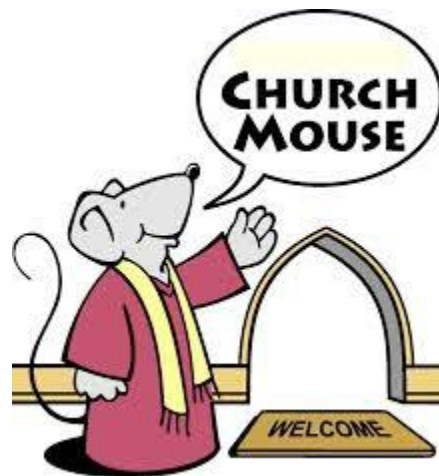

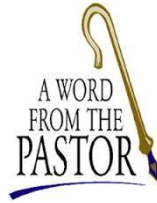

Dear Friends,
